Lynne Stephens Bio

Two time British world team member Lynne Stephens has brought a wide training experience with her from the U.K. She's trained a wide variety of breeds and handlers of all abilities. Lynne now lives in NC and competes in AKC and USDAA.

Following her initiation into the world of dog training with Brandy, her pet Cavalier King Charles Spaniel, Lynne discovered British Working Trials. These involve obedience, tracking, searching, agility and patrol work skills. In 1987 she went on to win the coveted Associated Sheep, Police and Army Dogs (ASPADS) Police Dog of the Year competition, to which only the country's best dogs and handlers were invited to compete. Lynne is now focusing much of her time to Dog Agility Training.

Lynne has qualified and gained top places in all the major U.K. agility finals, including Crufts and Olympia. Lynne and her husband Pete (who has also been on the British World Team) currently own six dogs, including two Cavalier King Charles Spaniels and four Border Collies. Lynne was a member of both the 2003 and 2004 British Agility World Championship Team with her Cavalier. Lynne's Border Collie Chess qualified and participated in Crufts and the 2004 British World Team tryouts, and in his first year in the US, quickly moved from Starters/Novice to the AKC Excellent B and USDAA Masters Levels. To top off Chess' first year in the US, Chess qualified for USDAA Grand Prix National Championships making it into semi-finals. Lynne also qualified Karen's BC Tag in the 2005 USDAA Steeplechase finals. Lynne has written several articles for the noted agility publication, Clean Run, and has been invited to contribute to their regular feature, "Ask the Experts."

Lynne's assistant and sister, Karen Mielke was born in England and moved to the U.S. in 1978. She began agility training in 1998 and competes at the highest levels of USDAA and AKC events. Karen has taught at both the Canine Capers agility club in Atlanta and the Shamrock dog training club in Louisville, Kentucky. Clicker training is one of her areas of expertise and she especially enjoys trick training the dogs on days too hot to do agility.
